Admission Test for Ph.D. (Political Science)

The admission to Ph.D programmes will be based on the candidates PG Marks and score in admission test (an equal weightage is provided to both components). All eligible candidates are required to appear for an admission test. The Ph.D admission test aims at testing the candidate's knowledge in social science research skills. The Ph.D admission test will have three components viz., written test, presentation of research proposal and personal interview as per details below:

* Each candidate has to prepare an original research proposal on a topic of his/her interest in advance and make a public presentation in the DRC Meeting. It is also necessary that the candidate submits a hard copy of her/his proposal at the time of presentation. The research proposal may include broadly Introduction, Review of Literature, and Statement of the Problem, Objectives, Research Questions/Hypotheses, Methodology, Tentative Chapterisation and References.

** At the time of the interview all the candidates are required to submit the original certificates for verification to the ***Convenor, MPhil/PhD Admissions.
