

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. Candidate will be admitted to the Examination Hall on production of this Admit Card. Admission will ordinarily be refused to a candidate who is more than half an hour late.
2. Loss of Admit Card must be reported to Establishment (Non-Teaching) immediately and duplicate copy of the same will be issued on payment of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty) only.
3. No candidate shall be permitted to leave the Examination Hall until an hour after the question papers have been distributed.
4. Seats should be occupied at least fifteen minutes before the commencement of the Examination.
5. Candidates should bring their pens, HB pencil and any other special requirements such as mathematical boxes, etc. for use in the Examination Hall. These will not be supplied by the Department.
6. Candidates should not bring any articles (other than those specified above) such as books, notes, loose sheets, mobile phones, papers, digital diaries, etc. **However they will be allowed to use battery operated simple pocket calculator as per the nature of question.**
7. Candidates must write in his own hand. Candidates with visual disability who would need the help of scribe should report themselves to Mizoram University (Establishment, Non-Teaching) two weeks prior to the commencement of the examination. Answer must not be written in pencil. Pencil may, however be used for maps, response sheet, mathematical drawing or rough works.
9. Candidates must attempt questions in accordance with the directions on each question papers. If the questions are attempted in excess of the prescribed number, only the questions attempted first up to the prescribed number shall be valued and the remaining ignored.
10. Answers once attempted will be considered as final and no overwriting will be accepted.
11. Wrongly numbered or unnumbered answer will not be evaluated.
12. Candidates detected in using unfair means or communicating one another or found in possession of unauthorized books and papers during the examination shall be expelled and their names struck off the rolls. They will be debarred from applying for all future examinations and selections to be conducted by the Mizoram University.
13. No candidates shall leave the Examination Hall without prior permission of the invigilator.
14. They must not write or revise their answers after the expiry of the allotted time.
15. Silence must be observed on the Examination Hall.
16. The candidates must abide by such instructions as may be specified on the cover of the answer book / response sheet or further instruction which may be given by the Centre Superintendent of the Exam. If the candidate fails to do so or indulge in disorderly or improper conduct, he / she will render himself / herself liable to expulsion from the examination and / or such other punishment as the authority deem fit to impose.
17. Any candidate found to be intoxicated with alcohol and / or drugs will be expelled from the Examination Hall.
18. Mobile phones, if any, brought to the examination will have to be left outside the Examination Hall and Mizoram University will not be responsible for their safe keeping.
19. Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) as per existing Government of Mizoram Rules will strictly be followed.
